YSC is Calgary's most comprehensive performing arts training and music education program, offering opportunities for participants of all ages and abilities.

YSC programs are housed at the ATCO Performing Arts Centre (APAC), a vibrant hub where young people come together to explore their creative potential.

What began as a choir of 25 singers has grown to include 15 choirs, reaching over 10,000 families in just 40 years. YSC offers inclusive programming, including STAR, where over 40 performers with cognitive delays explore the joy of singing, dancing and performing.

THE CHALLENGE

Through the Crescendo Capital Campaign, Youth Singers of Calgary (YSC) will bring its home into the public trust, making it a permanent community arts space in Calgary. To ensure longterm stability, affordability, and continued access for YSC and other community groups, YSC must fully own the ATCO Performing Arts Centre (APAC). Without this investment, the future of this vital arts space remains uncertain.

THE Solution

With significant financial and human resources invested in renovations and upgrades, APAC has become a vital space for hundreds of performers, educators, and over 70 local arts organizations.

YSC is working to secure its future as a permanent, community-owned performing arts space by raising \$1.5M by December 2026. By eliminating the financial burden of loan interest payments, YSC can redirect funds into critical programs and facility improvements. APAC is a legacy—one that inspires creativity, strengthens Calgary's creative industries, and contributes to the city's cultural and economic growth.

ATCO Performing Arts Centre (APAC) is an 18,000-square-foot creative hub, proudly serving as the home of the Youth Singers of Calgary (YSC), with over 15 fully subscribed programs. APAC welcomes many other community groups, offering affordable rentals that foster artistic growth and collaboration. More than just a venue, APAC provides a home for hundreds of kids and a vibrant space where the performing arts can thrive.

YSC raised \$1.8M to renovate an empty warehouse and create a purpose-built dedicated community space with the support of government and donors.

YSC raised \$1.9M to purchase their home, leaving a balance of \$1.2M. \$75,000/year are going towards interest payments. YSC re-launched the Crescendo Capital Campaign with the goal to raise an additional \$300,000 for a Capital Reserve Fund for ongoing stewardship of the building, bringing the total goal to \$1.5M. YSC to fully own and operate APAC, thereby cementing its status as a community resource for youth.
