Youth Singers of Calgary (YSC) enables youth to find themselves and their voice through integrated music, dance, and theatre arts education.

Through activities for young people (ages 3.5 and up) YSC sparks a life-long interest in the performing arts and fosters creative growth in a structured and supportive environment.

In addition to its core instructional and performing divisions, Youth Singers has expanded to offer STAR, a unique program for youth and young adults with cognitive delays; the HUB, an intergenerational informal alumni choir; and a daytime choir for students in alternative and homeschool settings.

YSC is steered by the principle that a musical education is for all, not an elite few, and providing opportunities for music appreciation and performance leads to a life-long positive impact.

Sing. Dance. Act. Those are the tools we use. But everyday we are creating community leaders and fostering teamwork, leadership, self-esteem and confidence.

The ATCO Performing Arts Centre (APAC), home of the Youth Singers of Calgary, is a vibrant community arts space that is used by many arts groups on a regular and single use basis. APAC provides much needed affordable rehearsal, performance, presentation and meeting space for local Calgary community groups and visitors alike.

For the hundreds of kids, teens, and adults who use APAC each week, this building in Calgary's southeast has become a safe space and a second home.

It is a place where people can learn, grow and express themselves through song and performance.

HOME IS WHERE OUR SONG IS!

The ATCO Performing Arts Centre is an 18,000 sq. ft. warehouse that was renovated and purpose-built as a rehearsal and performance venue to meet the needs of YSC and to offer affordable space to community art groups in Calgary.

The initial \$1.8 million investment included four studios, a recording studio, music library, costume and set building workshops, office space and much more.




